Time commitment	Approximately 8 hours a month depending on time of year
Skills & Qualifications	<p>Education Volunteers will be friendly and enjoy working with people of all ages, especially children.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Experience of leading/assisting activities in arts, crafts, wildlife and biodiversity would be an advantage but not essential. - Experience of software such as Word, Publisher and Powerpoint would be useful. <p>All volunteers working with children will be required to undergo a Disclosure and Barring Service check.</p>
Training & Support	<p>All volunteers will receive induction training.</p> <p>Ongoing training and support will be offered to all volunteers as the opportunity arises.</p>
Reimbursement of expenses	<p>Out of pocket expenses will be reimbursed:</p> <p>Mileage costs @ 40p per mile or the cost incurred using public transport.</p>
