<b>Role Title</b>	Oral history volunteer
<b>Location</b>	Various locations across the North Pennines

<b>Purpose of role</b>	<p>As part of the Nectarworks Project, we are looking for volunteers to take on one, or a combination of roles.</p> <p>Interviewer: record stories and memories from those that have kept bees in and around the North Pennines in years past.</p> <p>Transcriber: listen to and type up the interviews into a text document and get involved whilst staying at home; all you need is access to a computer.</p>
<b>Description of tasks</b>	<p>Volunteers can join the oral history team and focus on one element of the role, e.g. interviewer or transcriber or take part in both. You will be</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Interviewing candidates chosen by the project team and recording their memories via digital recording equipment.</li> <li>- Preparing recordings for archiving and transcription.</li> <li>- Listening to and transcribing recordings to form a text document of the interviews</li> </ul>
<b>Time commitment</b>	<p>One or two afternoons interviewing veteran beekeepers</p> <p>Transcription of one or two interviews</p>
<b>Skills &amp; Qualifications</b>	No previous experience is necessary as training will be provided.

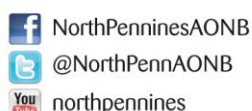
